1 You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying The Stained Glass Museum.

2 You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).

3 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that The Stained Glass Museum reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).

4 If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment tax return.

5 If you are unsure whether your donation qualifies for Gift Aid tax relief, you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
